Why it matters: the films borrow characters and events from the comics but tell their own version. When lore seems to disagree with a comic, the movie's version is what counts for the MCU.

Phases & Sagas

The MCU is organised into **phases** (release waves) that group into two giant **sagas**. Each saga builds to an Avengers finale.

The four tiers of canon

Not everything you read online is equally reliable. This guide sorts every claim into one of four levels — and tells you which one you're reading.



Canon

Shown on screen or stated by Marvel Studios. Locked-in fact.

E.G. Tony Stark dies in *Endgame*.



Soft canon

Strongly implied or referenced, but never spelled out directly.

E.G. exactly how many stones-worth of power Doom holds.



Informed theory

Reasoned prediction where Marvel hasn't confirmed anything yet.

E.G. how Doomsday sets up *Secret Wars*.



Rumor

Unverified reports and leaks. Fun, but hold it loosely.

E.G. surprise cameo speculation.

Six remnants of the universe's creation, each governing one fundamental force. Assembled in a gauntlet, they grant near-omnipotence.

Opens portals anywhere in existence. Powered the Tesseract that HYDRA and Loki fought over.

LOKI'S SCEPTRE · YELLOW

Controls minds and consciousness. Hidden in Loki's scepter; later gave life to Vision.

● Reality

THE AETHER · RED

Bends reality and matter to the user's will. Appeared as the liquid Aether in *Thor: The Dark World*.

● Power

THE ORB · PURPLE

Immense destructive energy. Sealed in the Orb the Guardians fought over on Xandar.

● Time

EYE OF AGAMOTTO · GREEN

Rewinds, fast-forwards and loops time. Worn by Doctor Strange as the Eye of Agamotto.

● Soul

VORMIR · ORANGE

Governs life and the soul itself. Demands "a soul for a soul" — the sacrifice on Vormir.

Thanos, the Snap & the Blip

How eleven years of films resolved in two: *Infinity War* (2018) and *Endgame* (2019).

01 · 2018

The Snap

Thanos completes the Gauntlet and erases half of all life in the universe with a single snap.

02 · 2018–23

The Blip

Five years pass with the vanished gone. The survivors grieve; the world adapts to being halved.

03 · 2023

The Time Heist

Using the Quantum Realm, the Avengers travel back to collect the stones from the past and reverse the Snap.

04 · 2023

"I am Iron Man"

Tony Stark snaps away Thanos and his army — sacrificing his life to save everyone.

Why it matters: the time heist splinters the timeline and plants the seeds of the Multiverse Saga — and Tony's death is the emotional anchor the entire franchise still orbits.

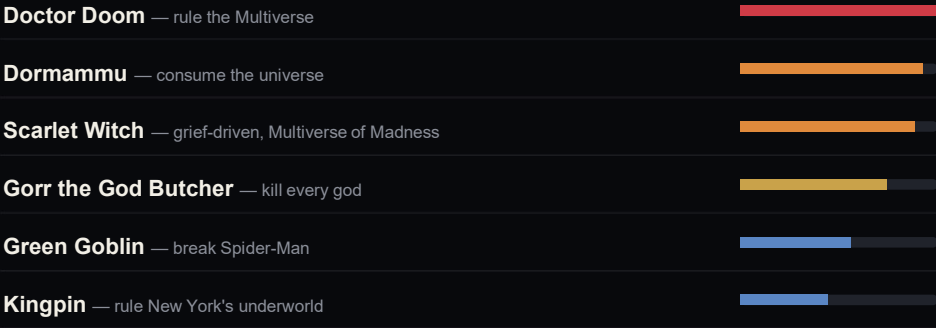
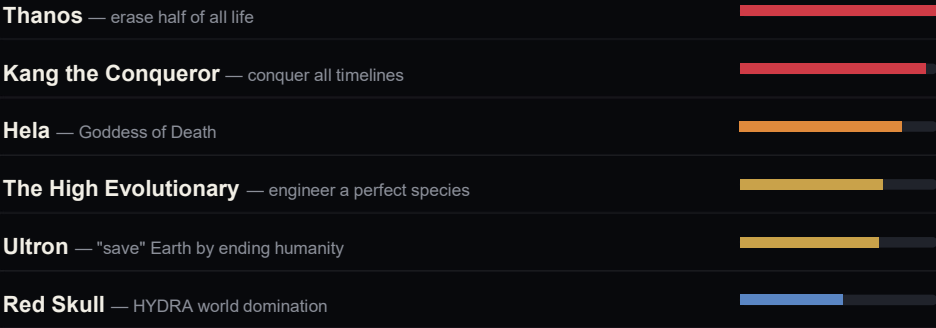

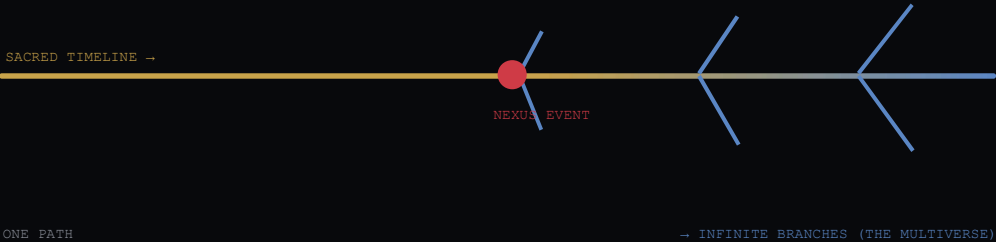

The single "approved" flow of history the TVA protected.

Nexus events

Moments where someone strays from their destined path, spawning a branch.

The TVA

The Time Variance Authority — the agency that once pruned every branch.

He Who Remains

The being who created the TVA to stop his own dangerous variants — the Kangs.

Loki's choice

Loki now sits at the center, manually holding the branches alive — the Multiverse Saga's fragile status quo.

• CANON — established across *Loki* Seasons 1-2.

PART NINE

The Multiverse.

Infinite parallel realities, each its own "Earth." It's how Marvel unites the old Fox and Sony movies with the MCU — and the battlefield the whole Multiverse Saga is fought on.

The retro-1960s reality of *The Fantastic Four: First Steps* (2025) — Marvel's First Family.

10005**The Fox X-Men**

Two decades of *X-Men* films. Its heroes finally cross into the MCU via the Multiverse.

Sony**The Spider-Verse**

Sony's Spider-Man worlds — bridged in *No Way Home*, where three Spider-Men met.

What If**Animated realities**

The *What If...?* series explores countless "what could have happened" branches — all canon.

- SOFT CANON — some designations are confirmed on screen; others follow Marvel's established comic numbering.

Crossing over — and colliding

Universes normally stay separate. Three things let characters cross — and one catastrophe destroys worlds entirely.

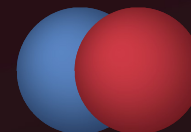
A Magic — Doctor Strange
Spells can tear openings between realities — and, when they go wrong, crack the barriers apart.

B The Quantum Realm & the TVA
A dimension beneath time. The Time Variance Authority polices crossings from outside it.

C Sheer power — Wanda, Doom
Beings strong enough can force their way across on their own.

THE DANGER

Incursions



When two universes drift into each other, they collide — and one, or both, is annihilated. Incursions are the doomsday clock of the Multiverse Saga, and the reason its finale is titled **Secret Wars**.

Time Travel & the Quantum Realm.

The MCU's time travel has one firm rule that a lot of fans get wrong. Here's how it actually works — and why it created the Multiverse.

The one rule that matters

Forget "change the past to fix the present." In the MCU, the past can't be rewritten — changing it only spins off a [new branch](#).

THE MECHANISM

The Quantum Realm

A dimension smaller than atoms where time and space stop behaving normally — the doorway to time travel.

Pym Particles

Hank Pym's shrinking tech — the only way to safely enter and navigate the Realm.

The Time Heist

In *Endgame*, the Avengers used both to revisit past events and borrow the Infinity Stones.

THE RULES

✗ You can't change your own past

Altering history doesn't fix your present — the timeline you came from stays exactly as it was.

✓ Changes create a branch

Interfering with the past spawns a new parallel timeline instead — the seed of the Multiverse.

✓ Return the stones to avoid branches

Cap put every borrowed stone back at the exact moment it was taken, closing the branches they'd have caused.

Why it matters: the time heist is literally what cracked the timeline open — connecting the Infinity Saga's ending to the Multiverse Saga's central crisis.

Technology & Artifacts.

The machines, metals and magic objects that make the impossible routine —
and often decide who wins.



The MCU's essential tech

The inventions and materials that recur across the whole saga.

The Arc Reactor

Tony Stark's miniaturized clean-energy core — it keeps him alive and powers every Iron Man suit.

Nanotech Armor

The Mark 50+ suits form instantly from a housing unit, shaping weapons on demand — the peak of Stark engineering.

Vibranium

Wakanda's near-indestructible, energy-absorbing metal. Makes Cap's shield and powers a nation.

Pym Particles

Shrink or enlarge any matter — and the key that unlocked Quantum-Realm time travel.

Mysterio's Illusions

Drone-projected holograms so convincing they faked a multiverse — a warning that not all "cosmic" threats are real.

TVA Technology

Time-manipulating tools — TemPads, reset charges and pruning devices — that operate outside of time itself.

PART TWELVE

Power Scale.

Who would actually win? A tiered look at the MCU's hierarchy of power — from street-level fighters to cosmic beings who outrank gods.

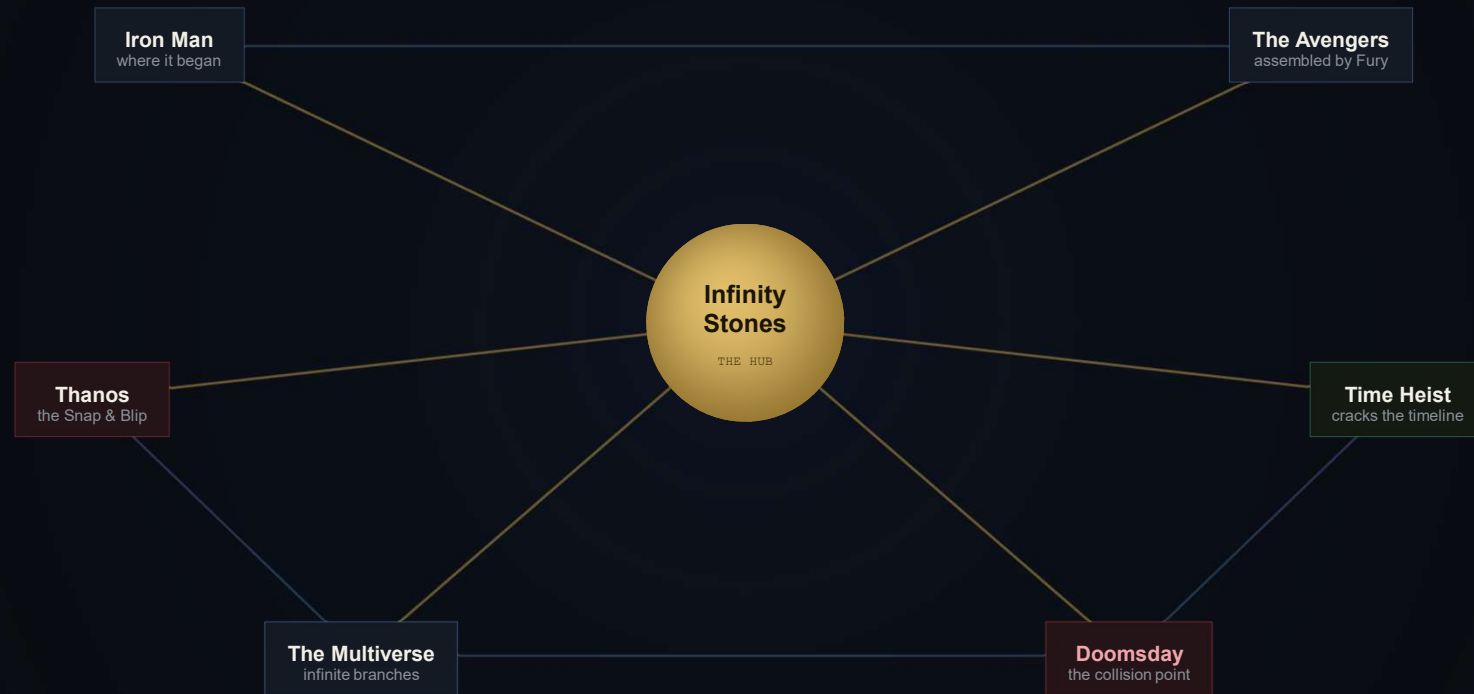

Watch everything in the order it premiered (2008 →). The way the story was meant to unfold, with every surprise intact.

Chronological

IN-STORY TIME

By in-universe timeline: start with Captain America: The First Avenger (1940s) and Captain Marvel (1990s), then forward.

Family-Friendly

LIGHTER TONE

Skip the R-rated and darker entries: the Avengers films, Guardians, Ant-Man, Spider-Man, Black Panther, Captain Marvel.

THE SHORTCUT

Endgame → Loki (S1–2) → No Way Home → Multiverse of Madness → Deadpool & Wolverine → Thunderbolts* → Fantastic Four.

04 Kang was set up, then dropped • THEORY

Marvel pivoted the saga's big bad from Kang to Doom; expect the story to bridge that.

05 Loki anchors the timeline • CANON

At the end of his series, Loki becomes the being holding the branching timelines together.

06 The New Avengers assembled • CANON

*Thunderbolts** (2025) reveals its team as the world's New Avengers.

07 Deadpool & the X-Men are in • CANON

Deadpool & Wolverine (2024) folded the Fox mutants into the Multiverse.

08 Secret Wars is the finale • CANON

"I am Iron Man." — the first words, and nearly the last, of the Infinity Saga.

THE FULL-CIRCLE IRONY

In 2026, Robert Downey Jr. returns to the MCU — but as Doctor Doom, not Tony Stark. The face that built this universe now threatens to unmake it. However Doom connects to Stark is Marvel's biggest guarded secret.
